VFW Post 233 POW Heroes:

<u>Norman Gibbs - U.S. Army Air Corps:</u> <i>Norm was a crew member on a B-17 bomber. Returning after a bombing run on Vienna Austria, his aircraft's engines slowly quit working – 1, 2, then 3. Engine #4 was overheating so the crew bailed out. Shortly after they landed they were captured by German soldiers. Norm then spent the rest of the war as a POW in a German camp.</i>	<u>Jack Gutting – U.S. Army:</u> <i>Jack was a member of the U.S. Army stationed on the island of Corregidor, in the Philippine Islands, when the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941. Shortly thereafter, the Japanese attacked Corregidor. After holding out for nearly 5 months, our troops were ordered to surrender. Jack was taken prisoner and sent to Japan to work in the forced labor camps for the next 3 1/2 years.</i>	<u>Roy Urich – U.S. Army Air Corps:</u> <i>Roy was a tail gunner on a B-17. During a bombing mission in Europe his plane was hit by anti-aircraft fire and the tail section was blown away. Roy was able to extricate himself and parachuted to safety. Soon after he was captured by the Germans and spent the next 1 ½ years in a German POW camp.</i>
