PROJECT GOLD STAR Help Make Gold Star Family License Plates a Reality

What is a Gold Star Family? "Gold Star Family" is a term used to describe a family who has lost a loved one while serving on active duty in military service during any American involved conflict.

On September 26, 2008, after a two year battle with California's legislators, Governor Schwarzenegger signed SB1455 (also known as the Gold Star Family License Plate Bill). SB1455 authorizes the creation of a special recognition license plate program in California to honor our Gold Star Families. These family members, as defined by the Department of Defense, will be able to apply for a special license plate with a design containing a Gold Star and the words "Gold Star Family." The plate pictured below will be available to honor the sacrifice of military personnel from ***all conflicts***.

Due to the current economic state of California, the Gold Star Family license plates will not be produced with any monies from California's General Fund. There just is no money. The California Department of Motor Vehicles requires \$300,000 in start up costs to begin production on the Gold Star Family license plate and will not begin producing them until the money is raised by private donations.

We should never let the memory of those who have given their all drift away. Can you think of a better way to sanctify their sacrifice and to honor the families whose lives were changed forever than by getting these Gold Star Family license plates produced?
