VIETNAM VETERANS OF AMERICA, CALIFORNIA STATE COUNCIL LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

June 7, 2012

Friday, June 1st was one of the important legislative deadlines. Legislation was required to pass out of the House it was introduced in (House of Origin) to the other House or the legislation is dead. Below is an updated bill list. Please note in the commentary section those that did not make the deadline.

While regular committee meetings on legislation continue as bills move through their second House, the attention of the Legislature and Governor will focus on the annual budget. The budget deadline is June 30th.

The schedule for the remainder of the legislative session is as follows: if the budget passes, the Legislature will take a summer recess beginning on July 6th. The Legislature is scheduled to reconvene on August 6th and they will work on legislation until adjournment on August 31st. Any bill that does not pass by the end of session is dead as this is the second year of a two year session. The Governor will have until September 30th to sign or veto the bills which passed.
